

Hidden Pointe on the Lake Garbage Can Enclosure Criteria

Garbage Can Enclosures may be:

1. Constructed of pressure treated wood or brick. See examples below of approved structures.
2. If no gate is provided, the structure, if mounted to the rear of the house or on the side of the house should have the interior shielded from view from the front street and/or side street by having a single open access facing away from the street/s.
3. If made of wood, it should be stained with Behr 501 or equivalent wood preservative/stain color.
4. If made of brick, use only Coventry Brick matching the home.
5. Enclosure floor **may** include pavers or concrete pad.
6. No side of the enclosure should exceed 6 feet long and the enclosure should be 5 feet tall.
7. The enclosure, if located on the side of the house, must be set back a minimum of 4 feet from the front of the house, location to be approved by the BOD.
