

Pool Rules
Revised June 2010

1. The pool will be open for use from 7:00 am until 11:00pm.
2. Homeowners must accompany guests to pool and remain until identification of such is determined with other homeowners.
3. Homeowner is responsible for their visitor.
4. Users of the pool must be courteous and alert to any unsafe conditions.
5. Everyone must shower before entering the pool.
6. **NO GLASS CONTAINERS OR BREAKABLE OBJECTS PERMITTED.** This is a North Carolina State law. Violators subject to fine.
7. No eating drinking or smoking while in the pool.
8. **NO LITTERING.** Please bring a bag to remove your trash. Take it with you or use receptacles stored behind clubhouse.
9. Please bring a container for ashes and cigarette butts. Do not use OUR property.
10. Abusive language, intoxication, boisterous conduct or vandalism will not be tolerated.
11. No loud playing of radios. Radios with headphones are preferred.
12. Children 12 years of age and under must be accompanied, supervised and protected by a person at least 16 years of age.
13. Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool. (No cutoff jeans or filter clogging clothing.)
14. Children not yet toilet trained must wear appropriate swimwear. Should an "accident" occur please make every possible effort to remove the "evidence" promptly. Notify a Board member or our management company. This is a potential health hazard for others in the pool. **Disposable diapers are not allowed as swimwear.**
15. Life rings and other safety equipment are for emergency use only.
16. No diving into the pool. No pushing, running or shoving anywhere in the pool area.
17. Pets are not permitted inside the pool area except certified service dogs.

18. Please tie umbrellas down after use.

19. Each table has 4 chairs. If extra seating is needed, please bring it with you.

20. The HOA is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

21. Anyone not adhering to the above rules will be instructed to leave.

Violation of the above rules will result in the due process set forth by this Homeowners Association.
